 - K-6: (primary: fundamental science)
 - o 7-12: look at long term careers good education
 - o Undergraduate: more sure of goals but identify engineering education shortfalls
 - o Early career: broad topics and intro to field
 - Mid-late career: specific topics
- Baseline: IEEE Education Societies
 - Build on existing knowledge
 - Have first-hand information relevant to educational interest
 - Seem to focus on instructional system design -> derive best practices for teaching
 - Conference in NZ on teaching assessment and learning
 - Need to determine issues underlying educational shortfall
